## August Gardening 2008

This is the last month for fertilizing. Plants need to start getting ready for colder temperatures rather than putting forth new growth. Fertilize only healthy grass. No fertilizer if disease is present. Centipede doesn't need fertilizing unless you have very sandy soil. Instead, add chelated iron if you want a greener color. Put 6 lb. 16-4-8 per 1000 sq. ft. on St. Augustine, 10 lb. 14-4-8 per 1000 sq ft on Bermuda and Zoysia, and 3 lb. 16-4-8 per 1000 sq. ft. on Centipede. Fertilize roses with 1 Tablespoon 10-10-10 per ft. of height. Keep fertilizing houseplants, container plants, and annuals with water soluble 20-20-20. Lightly fertilize perennials if needed. Continue to deadhead (remove) faded annual and perennial flowers as well as crape myrtle flowers. Stop cutting back chrysanthemums and let buds start to grow. Trim back, by 1/3, the leggy growth of annuals and perennials to get fall flowers. Keep cutting back herbs so they won't go to seed. No more serious pruning. You may trim shrubs of unwanted growth. You will lose next years flowers if you cut back azaleas. Hydrangeas can be shaped but remember that next years flowers grow on this year's wood. Plant seeds of zinnias, marigolds and other fast growing annuals for fall flowers. Irrigate deeply only as needed and only in the early morning. Use soaker hoses to keep leaves dry. Anything you plant now will need lots of water to get established. Best to plant new things on a cloudy day. Watch out for spider mites (faded and stippled leaves) and aphids (sooty mold on leaves). Knock them off with a strong spray of water or if heavily infested use insecticidal soap or horticultural oil. Remove plants heavily infested with powdery mildew. This is a good time to look around your yard and make notes for next year. Make notes of which ones did well so you can use them next year, note what perennials you want to move in early winter to another spot, and list plants you don't want to use next year. Look in other people's yards and note what plants do well through the summer.
